2022 New Jersey Election Timeline

Sept. 5 – Labor Day

Sept. 6 – Candidate petition deadline for November non-partisan election (subject to change)

Sept. 24 – VBM ballots mailed: general election voting begins

October 18 – Voter registration deadline: general election

Oct. 29-Nov. 6 – Early voting: general election

November 1 – VMB application deadline by-mail: general election

November 7 – VBM application deadline in-person: general election

November 8 – Election Day: general election

November 14 – VBM ballot must be received by county to be counted

November 21 – County Board of Elections meetings

December 6 – Election Day: non-partisan run-off & school bond
